<b>acquiesce</b>	to agree
<b>assemblage</b>	a gathering of a group of people
<b>agitated</b>	to have troubled thoughts and feelings of disturbance
<b>belligerent</b>	to be angry and upset
<b>draft</b>	to be required to serve in the military
<b>mesmerized</b>	to find something fascinating or irresistible
<b>napalm</b>	a thickener used in jelling gasoline for a kind of fire bomb that was widely used during the Vietnam War
<b>pacifism</b>	to be opposed to all violence and war as a means of settling disputes, to refuse to bear arms on moral or religious principals
<b>psychedelic</b>	distorted, bizarre images and color schemes especially popular during the 1960s
<b>survey</b>	to look over or view an area
<b>underground press</b>	newspapers and other literary medium produced outside the establishment or mainstream press by an informal movement or group
